II TIMOTHY 1:3-5

Encouragement to Be Faithful

3 Timothy, I thank God for you—the God I serve with a clear conscience, just as my ancestors did. Night and day I constantly remember you in my prayers.

4 I long to see you again, for I remember your tears as we parted. And I will be filled with joy when we are together again.

5 I remember your genuine faith, for you share the faith that first filled your grandmother Lois and your mother, Eunice. And I know that same faith continues strong in you.

DAY 2 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 3-5

1. Paul thanked God for Timothy as he did what (verse 3)? What does this tell us about Paul's prayer life?
2. What does Paul specifically remember in verse 4? Do you think God cares about our tears? Why or why not?
3. Timothy's heritage of faith came from his mother and grandmother (vs. 5). Do you think this is why Paul calls him his "child" in verse 2? Can we have spiritual fathers or mentors that are not our biological fathers?
