II TIMOTHY 2: 8-13

NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

8 Always remember that Jesus Christ, a descendant of King David, was raised from the dead. This is the Good News I preach.

9 And because I preach this Good News, I am suffering and have been chained like a criminal. But the word of God cannot be chained. **10** So I am willing to endure anything if it will bring salvation and eternal glory in Christ Jesus to those God has chosen.

11 This is a trustworthy saying:

If we die with him,
we will also live with him.

12 If we endure hardship,
we will reign with him.

If we deny him,
he will deny us.

13 If we are unfaithful,
he remains faithful,
for he cannot deny who he is.

DAY 3 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 8-13

1. How would life be different if we constantly remembered Jesus (vs. 8)?
2. Though Paul is chained, what is not chained (vs. 9)? If God's Word is not chained, what kind of lives do we have the potential to live?
3. Paul endures suffering for the sake of those who will come to know Jesus (vs. 10). Who can Jesus not deny (vs. 13)? If we are in His family, what does this mean for us (vs. 11-13)?
