II TIMOTHY 2:16-21

NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

16 Avoid worthless, foolish talk that only leads to more godless behavior. **17** This kind of talk spreads like cancer, as in the case of Hymenaeus and Philetus. **18** They have left the path of truth, claiming that the resurrection of the dead has already occurred; in this way, they have turned some people away from the faith.

19 But God's truth stands firm like a foundation stone with this inscription: "The LORD knows those who are his," and "All who belong to the LORD must turn away from evil."

20 In a wealthy home some utensils are made of gold and silver, and some are made of wood and clay. The expensive utensils are used for special occasions, and the cheap ones are for everyday use. **21** If you keep yourself pure, you will be a special utensil for honorable use. Your life will be clean, and you will be ready for the Master to use you for every good work.

DAY 5 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 16-21

1. Irreverent babble and false theology will spread like what (vs. 17)? What was the false message that was being spread (vs. 18)?
2. Verse 20 speaks of different kind vessels for different use. What does verse 21 show us about our choice to be cleansed and useful to God?
3. What do you think it means to be useful to the Master (vs. 21)?
