## II TIMOTHY 3: 16-17

NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

**13** But evil people and impostors will flourish. They will deceive others and will themselves be deceived.

**14** But you must remain faithful to the things you have been taught. You know they are true, for you know you can trust those who taught you. **15** You have been taught the holy Scriptures from childhood, and they have given you the wisdom to receive the salvation that comes by trusting in Christ Jesus.

### DAY 6 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 16-17

1. Breath is life. If God literally breathes scripture, what does that imply about its importance (vs. 16)? What is it profitable for (vs. 15)?
2. What are the differences between teaching, reproof, correction, and training (vs. 15)? How does God's Word do different things in different situations?
3. What is the ultimate result of God's Word in a Christian's life (vs. 17)? How difficult is it to face situations unequipped for what you're facing?
