II TIMOTHY 4: 6-8

NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

6 As for me, my life has already been poured out as an offering to God. The time of my death is near. **7** I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, and I have remained faithful. **8** And now the prize awaits me—the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on the day of his return. And the prize is not just for me but for all who eagerly look forward to his appearing.

DAY 3 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 6-8

1. Paul knows that his death is approaching (vs. 6). How do you think this fact changed the impact of this letter for Timothy? Does it change it for you?
2. What three things does Paul proclaim in verse 7? How can we fight, finish, and keep the faith in our own lives?
3. How should the crown that God will give to Paul and all of us who “look forward to his appearing” affect our perceptions in the midst of difficult daily living (vs. 8)?
