## II TIMOTHY 4: 19-22

### **Paul's Final Greetings**

**19** Give my greetings to Priscilla and Aquila and those living in the household of Onesiphorus. **20** Erastus stayed at Corinth, and I left Trophimus sick at Miletus.

**21** Do your best to get here before winter. Eubulus sends you greetings, and so do Pudens, Linus, Claudia, and all the brothers and sisters.

**22** May the Lord be with your spirit. And may his grace be with all of you.

### DAY 6 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 19-22

1. How valuable are our friends of which we share a common faith (vs. 19)?
2. How confusing is it that a man like Paul who performed such amazing miracles writes that Trophimus is ill? What does this reveal to us about the divine sovereignty of healing and miracles? How can we take heart from this?
3. In his final words, Paul prays grace for Timothy (vs. 22). How does grace eclipse everything?
