## COLOSSIANS 1: 21-23

NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

**21** This includes you who were once far away from God. You were his enemies, separated from him by your evil thoughts and actions. **22** Yet now he has reconciled you to himself through the death of Christ in his physical body. As a result, he has brought you into his own presence, and you are holy and blameless as you stand before him without a single fault.

**23** But you must continue to believe this truth and stand firmly in it. Don't drift away from the assurance you received when you heard the Good News. The Good News has been preached all over the world, and I, Paul, have been appointed as God's servant to proclaim it.

### DAY 5 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 21-23

1. What once separated us from God (vs. 21)? Can these things still separate us?
2. Because of Jesus' death, what is our status as we stand before God (vs. 22)? Is this true even when we don't feel like it?
3. What must we continue to do (vs. 23)? What possibilities in our relationship with God does the word "drift" indicate (vs. 23)?
