COLOSSIANS 3: 12-15

NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

12 Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience. **13** Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. **14** Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. **15** And let the peace that comes from Christ rule in your hearts. For as members of one body you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful.

DAY 4 REFLECTION QUESTIONS FOR VERSES 12-15

1. Verse 12 tells us more things to be clothed with. What are they and what do you think it means to “be clothed” with them?
2. Verse 13 is the central essence of the message of Christ in regards to how we should live! What is it? Why must we forgive others (vs. 13)?
3. What binds us together in harmony (vs. 14)? If we are told to clothe ourselves with love, does this indicate we have a choice to do so or not? How will life change if we love by spiritual choice instead of by emotions or feelings?
4. What are we to let rule in our hearts (vs. 15)? Again, do we have a choice?
