PHILIPPIANS 2: 4-11

NEW LIVING TRANSLATION (NLT)

- 4** Don't look out only for your own interests, but take an interest in others, too.
- 5** You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.
- 6** Though he was God,
he did not think of equality with God
as something to cling to.
- 7** Instead, he gave up his divine privileges;
he took the humble position of a slave
and was born as a human being.
When he appeared in human form,
- 8** he humbled himself in obedience to God
and died a criminal's death on a cross.
- 9** Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor
and gave him the name above all other names,
- 10** that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow,
in heaven and on earth and under the earth,
- 11** and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord,
to the glory of God the Father.
